Siting Requirements and Variations



There are regulations about the distance buildings can be from your property boundaries and other aspects relating to the location of your building on your land. The plans you submit for a building permit must demonstrate that you comply with these regulations.

In some circumstances you may be able to apply for a variation to these siting regulations (called an 'application for report and consent'). Your application will need to include:

- Completed relevant application form from the list below
- Comments from adjoining landholders link below
- Fee of \$256.90

The decision guidelines are set by the Minister for Planning. Please address these decision guidelines carefully in your application. Approval of your application for a variation will depend on you demonstrating that your plans for a variation meet these guidelines.
