Who is eligible for free influenza vaccinations?

- Children aged between 6 months old and less than 5 years old.
- People aged 5 years and over who have medical risk factor that increases their risk of complications from influenza
- Aboriginal people aged 15 years and over
- Pregnant women
- Adults aged 65 years and over

* note that the influenza vaccine is not linked to the No Jab, No Pay or Play requirements.
