

Within the Shire of Murrindindi, residents and non-residents can utilise the services provided by five Resource Recovery Centres (Transfer Stations). For those residents who are not located within an area serviced by our kerbside garbage/recycling collection, Resource Recovery Centres (RRCs) are the primary solution for waste disposal. Council operates RRCs in Alexandra, Yea, Kinglake, Eildon and Marysville.

Fees are differentiated between waste from within Murrindindi, generated by ratepayers and residents of Murrindindi and businesses based in Murrindindi, versus waste generated outside of the Shire and brought into the Shire by people who do not reside in Murrindindi or businesses based outside of Murrindindi.

* A maximum of 1m³ of commercial waste will be accepted at RRCs. All loads exceeding 1m³ will be directed to dispose directly into landfill.

** A maximum of 3m³ of municipal/residential waste will be accepted. All loads exceeding this limit will be directed to dispose directly into landfill.

*** All green waste disposed at Council's RRCs is processed into a coarse grade mulch that can be collected from the RRC free of charge by any ratepayers or local businesses (on availability). Council does not warrant the quality of the mulch - it is an uncomposted woody mulch and may contain live weeds, weed seeds and litter.

Unacceptable Waste at Council's RRCs:

- Loads of unrecyclable material exceeding 3m³
- Asbestos
- Chemicals and solvents
- Prescribed waste
- Hazardous or contaminated waste (including medical waste and syringes)
- Dirty chemical containers all containers must be triple rinsed and will be checked for residue
- Any liquid waste except motor oil

Asbestos:

Chemicals and solvents:

Sustainability Victoria runs the Detox Your Home program which arranges permanent and event based collections of household chemicals at locations throughout Victoria. Unfortunately they do not offer a collection in Murrindindi – the nearest collection points are event based collections in Coldstream and Seymour. Syringes:

Council offers a free disposal service for used hypodermic needles and syringes. Contact a Council office to obtain a sharp safe container. Once the container has been filled, it can be returned and swapped for another. This service is not available to commercial operators.

What can I do to make my waste drop off as easy and efficient as possible?

Sorting your load out when loading your trailer can help you to save time when you reach your local RRC, but it can also **save you money.** As quite a number of recyclable items can be dropped off free of charge, if these items are sorted into separate piles in your load, they are easily identifiable and measurable by our RRC operators.
