

What is drumMUSTER?

DrumMuster provides the opportunity for the collection and recovery of otherwise non-returnable metal and plastic agricultural and veterinary (agvet) chemical containers. This enables eligible containers to be disposed of free of charge, minimising the environmental impact of incorrect disposal of such containers.

Which containers are eligible for drumMUSTER?

Eligible drums must meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Contain the drumMUSTER logo somewhere on the container
- ✓ Be above one litre/kilogram and up to 205 litre/kilogram capacity
- ✓ Have no chemical residue on the inside/outside of the container or on the cap/thread (dirt, rust and dye stains are acceptable)
- ✓ Have lids removed
- ✓ If the container is metal, the top needs to be pierced on the top and the bottom



Where can I recycle my eligible chemical containers?

DrumMUSTER collection facilities are available at the following Resource Recovery Centres free of charge:

- ✓ Yea
- ✓ Kinglake

What if my container still has chemicals in it?

What happens to the drums after they have been collected for recycling?

The collected drums are processed for recycling, and are processed either by being shredded, granulated or heat-extruded back to resin. After initial processing, the raw materials are processed into new materials, such as:

- ♻ Wheelie bins
- ♻ Fence posts
- ♻ Irrigation pipes
- ♻ Bollards
- ♻ Barstools (concrete supports)
