



Sally Dean's Book review - The Man Who Died Twice by Richard Osman

I always wonder, when a known personality/comedian such as Osman, writes a book, whether there will be substance. Or do they just think, because they are who they are, they can write too. In this case, he can. His four septuagenarians are delightful as they follow the trail of stolen diamonds. A retired MI5 agent, former nurse, psychiatrist and a Unionist all live in a retirement village. When the former spook Elizabeth's ex husband (still working for MI5) turns up needing help, she and her friends hide him, along with a junior agent.

A side story, is when the psychiatrist gets mugged, the other three decide to punish the offender. Two local police officers involved in following a drug dealer, help.

What follows is an offbeat, comic crime story, involving betrayal, murder, justice and love. Yes there is a love story, and reading about the fellow changing his lifestyle for a woman, is endearing. The former nurse, Joyce, writes in a journal, and her musings are colourful and amusing.



This is a sequel, but I haven't read the first book. It didn't take away from it though. Thoroughly enjoyable.
