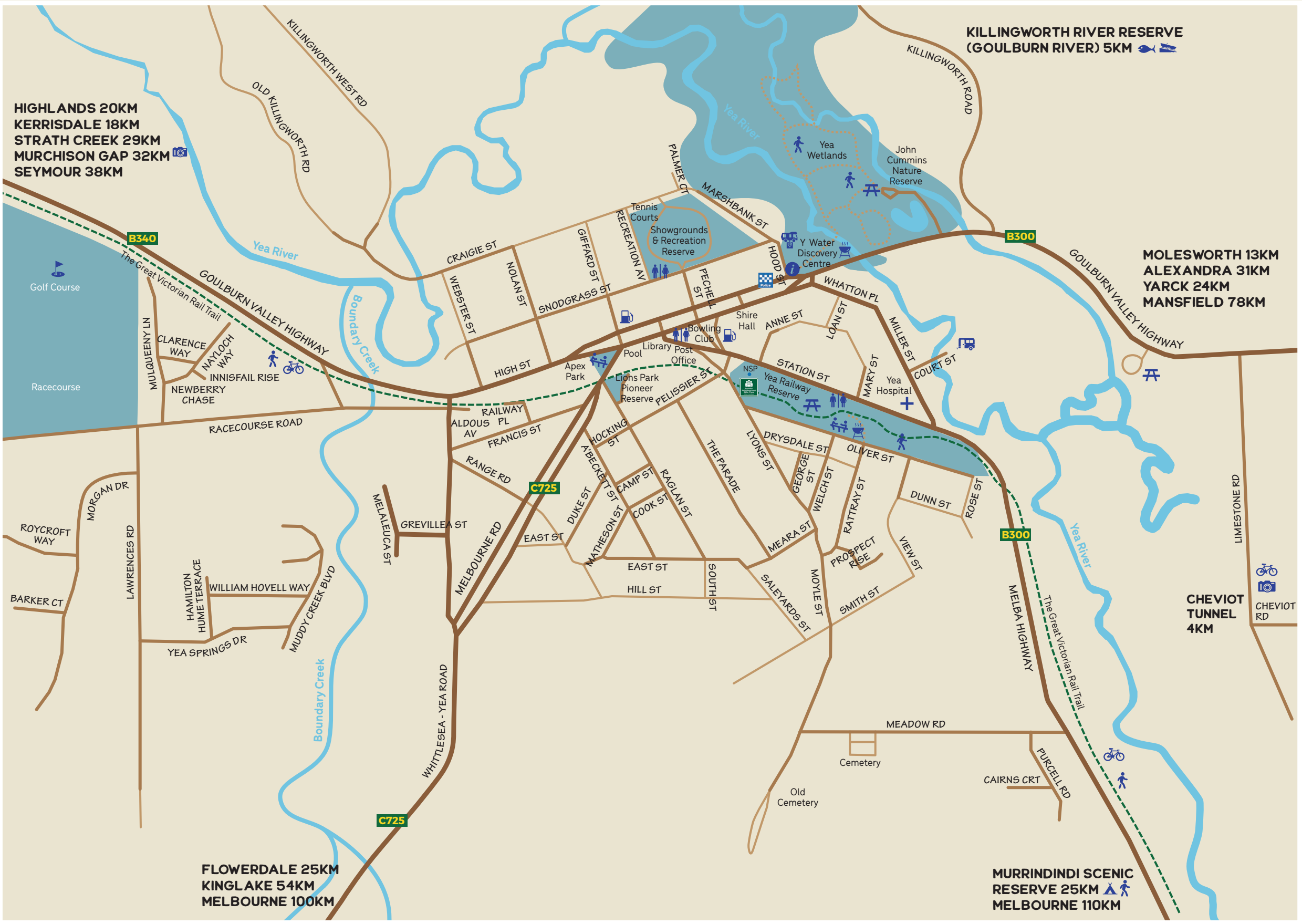


YEA
